PUBLIC NOTICE OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE AWARD OF TEACHING CONTRACTS ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027

1. The Department of Human Sciences announces the need, for the 2026/2027 Academic Year, to fill the following teaching positions through the award of teaching contracts pursuant to Article 23(2) of Italian Law No. 240/2010:
 - **ELEMENTS OF EDUCATIONAL SCIENCES**
 - **PSYCHOMETRICS I**
 - **PSYCHOMETRICS II**
2. The characteristics of each teaching position are provided in the attached information sheet (**Annex A**) and include:
 - a) Academic disciplinary sector;
 - b) Degree programme;
 - c) Type of teaching activity required;
 - d) Brief description of the course learning objectives;
 - e) Number of university credits (ECTS);
 - f) Nature of the appointment (paid or unpaid).
3. Applications must be submitted using the attached application form (Annex B) and accompanied by an up-to-date *curriculum vitae*. Applications may be submitted by either of the following methods:

 - By hand delivery to the University's headquarters at Via Plinio n. 44

Applications must be received no later than 6:00 p.m. on 17 August 2026.

4. Applications may be submitted by:
 - Individuals who are not Professors or Researchers currently employed by Italian or foreign universities;
 - Individuals possessing appropriate scientific and professional qualifications;
 - Individuals who will not exceed 85 years of age during the Academic Year in which the appointment is awarded.
5. A PhD degree or an equivalent qualification obtained abroad, as well as the national scientific qualification obtained pursuant to the procedures set out in Article 16 of Law no. 240 of 23 December 2010 (provided that the latter has not been followed by an appointment by a university), shall constitute preferential qualifications.
6. If no applications are received for a particular teaching position by the above deadline, the call for that position will be reopened for an additional 15 days. Notice of the reopening will be published on the University's website. This procedure will be repeated until at least

one application has been received for each position, unless the Department Council or Board of Administration decides otherwise.

7. Where only one candidate applies for a position, the candidate's suitability must nevertheless be assessed. This assessment may be carried out directly by the relevant Department or, where appropriate, by the Department Director (subject to subsequent ratification), without appointing a Selection Committee. The applicant will be notified of the outcome. If the candidate is deemed unsuitable, the procedure described in point 6 will apply.
8. For each position receiving more than one application, a comparative evaluation will be conducted by a Selection Committee appointed by the Department Council.

The Committee will evaluate applications according to the following criteria:

- a) Relevance of the applicant's academic and professional background to the subject of the appointment: up to 15 points
- b) Possession of a Master's degree, second-level Master's degree, PhD, or specialist qualification relevant to the appointment: up to 5 points
- c) Relevant academic achievements: up to 5 points
- d) Relevant professional qualifications: up to 5 points

Total: 30 points

Candidates obtaining at least 16 out of 30 points will be deemed eligible.

9. Within 15 days of the deadline for this call for applications, the Commission shall draw up a ranked list of eligible candidates for each position. This ranked list, together with the documentation relating to the evaluation procedure, shall be approved by the Rector and published on the University's website. Candidates have 7 days from the date of publication to lodge an appeal. Once this period has elapsed, and in the absence of any appeals, the ranked list shall be deemed approved, and the Administration shall proceed to award the teaching contract. The ranked lists are valid only for the academic year in which the procedure took place. In the event of a candidate declining the offer or the early termination of the appointment, the position may be awarded to another eligible candidate, in accordance with the ranking order.
10. The Selection Committee will meet at least once each month to conduct evaluations until all positions covered by this notice have been filled, unless otherwise decided by the Department Council or Board of Administration.
11. If the selected candidate is already employed by the University, the teaching contract may be concluded only after obtaining authorization from the General Director to undertake the appointment.

12. Teaching staff appointed under these contracts must carry out the following duties throughout the 2026/2027 Academic Year:
- a) Conduct examinations in accordance with the University's Academic Regulations, Student Regulations, and the operational guidelines issued by the University;
 - b) Organize a number of virtual classroom sessions each academic year at least equal to the number of CFU assigned to the course, ensuring that at least 20% of the total scheduled contact teaching hours are delivered synchronously;
 - c) Hold coordination meetings with the course tutor, with a minimum number of meetings equal to the number of examination sessions scheduled during the academic year;
 - d) Provide student office hours in coordination with the course tutor;
 - e) Complete the course information sheet, in both Italian and English, within the deadlines established by the University;
 - f) Ensure that video lectures and supplementary teaching materials are complete, up to date, and compliant with the University's quality standards, requirements, and guidelines;
 - g) Where required, record video lectures in accordance with the quantity, quality, and production schedule established by the relevant University offices.

Course Learning Objectives	Psychometrics I introduce students to the foundations of statistical reasoning and measurement in psychology. The module focuses on understanding, describing, and interpreting psychological data rather than on advanced mathematical computation. Students are introduced to descriptive statistics, probability concepts, and the logic of inferential statistics, with particular attention to how data are generated, summarised, and analysed in psychological research. The course covers key topics such as measurement scales, types of variables, data collection methods, and data screening, followed by an in-depth exploration of descriptive statistics and distributional properties. Students will learn the conceptual foundations of hypothesis testing, significance testing, confidence intervals, and effect sizes. Basic inferential techniques, including t-tests, chi-square tests, correlation, regression, and selected nonparametric tests, are introduced at a conceptual and interpretive level. Emphasis

	is placed on understanding statistical output, critical interpretation of results, and appropriate use of methods in psychological research contexts.

Course Learning Objectives	Psychometrics II builds on the statistical and measurement foundations introduced in Psychometrics 1, focusing on advanced approaches to psychological measurement and data analysis. The module examines key principles of test construction, reliability, and validity, and introduces students to methods used to evaluate and improve psychological scales. Students will explore regression models, factor analysis, and structural equation modelling, with emphasis on understanding the logic, assumptions, and interpretation of these techniques. The course also addresses contemporary issues in
